Flower Show & Competition Raj Bhawan, Dehradun, 01st, 2nd & 3rd March, 2024 <u>Rules & Regulations</u>

- I. The show is open to all commercial flower growers, Institutions, Individuals as per categories specified in the entry form. However cut flower competition is only for individuals/ farmers, institutions are not allowed.
- II. Each participant is required to fill up the entry form (except school children painting category) and submit at the designated address.
- III. The programme will be held at Raj Bhawan, Dehradun.
- IV. All potted exhibits shall be brought to the venue by the participating institutions / individuals on their own, within the time limit.
- V. The participants must bring their own containers and flowers. Potted plants will be evaluated on the basis of size, quality, blooms, health of foliage, etc. Cut flowers will be judged by the size, quality and uniformity of the flowers etc.
- VI. No participant shall accompany or try to influence the judges in any manner. Participant found using unfair means shall be disqualified from the competition.
- VII. No participant or relative of a participant shall be a part of the evaluation team.
- VIII. All entries shall be of the plants grown by the exhibitors themselves.
- IX. All potted exhibits must be grown in pots.
- X. While every care will be taken to protect exhibits. Organizers will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any exhibit.
- XI. For Rangoli, only floral petals may be used. The petals shall not have remnants or adjuncts of flowers. No color, adhesive, moist spray, stencil etc shall be used over the designated space of one square meter for this competition. The entire design has to be completed within time. This competition is open for individuals above 12 years of age. No assistance will be allowed.
- XII. For on-the spot photography category, photographers are eligible to click Plants/ Plant parts/ flowers/ Bunches / Arrangements, displayed in the flower show on 1st March, 2024. The best 2 pictures clicked should be displayed on same day up to 02:00 PM for judgment.
- XIII. Each exhibitor/ entry shall be allotted an entry number for each category after arrangement of the exhibits. They will be responsible for attaching this number to exhibits. The exhibits shall not, in any case, have any identification of the participant, as this can influence the decision of the judges.
- XIV. First, second and third prizes shall be awarded in each category.
- XV. Prize distribution shall be held at Raj Bhawan, Dehradun on 3rd March, 2024 at 4:00 pm.
- XVI. Exhibits may be removed only after the prize distribution is over or as per decision of Hon'ble Governor, Uttarakhand.
- XVII. Use of artificial flowers will not be allowed in the competition.
- XVIII. Each and every entry should have a tag indicating name of the plant / flower.
- XIX. If the Judges suspects that any entry has been hired / purchased from market the entry will be disqualified.

XX. Running Trophy will be provided to the institution which gets maximum prizes.

- XXI. Evaluation of exhibits by the Judges would be done on established scientific methods and criteria.
